1. Short title and Commencement -(1) These rules may be called the Kerala Service (Amendment) Rules,1992

2. Amendment of the rules In Kerala Service Rules in Appendix VII, under the heading Section III-Compensation Leave" in condition (ii) for the words "twelve days" the words "fifteen days" shall be substituted.
