ORDER

As required in the letter read as 1st paper above the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Social Forestry & Vigilance) has forwarded a scheme for compensatory afforestation of an area of 57180 ha. of degraded forest land at a cost of Rs. 113 crores to be implemented within the period of 10 years commencing from 1993-94, in lieu of the regularization of Pre- 1977 forest encroachments in 28588.159 hectares of forest land.

The Government have examined the schemes in details and found that the scheme is acceptable. In the circumstances Administrative Sanction is accorded for the implementation of the scheme from 1993-94 onwards.
