ORDER

In the Government Order read as first paper, sanction was accorded for the implementation of the "India Eco-Development Project in Periyar Tiger Reserve" in the State Forest Department with World Bank assistance. The Project implementation period is 5 years commencing from 1st December 1996. In the above Government Order, it was specified that the required staff should be provided through re-deployment of staff appointed for the Social Forestry Project which was wound up in 1993. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Wildlife) has in his letter read second, reported that the entire staff of the Social Forestry Wing is engaged otherwise for implementation of the Compensatory Afforestation Scheme, Kerala Social Forestry Project II etc. and that there are no excess staff for redeployment for this scheme.

2. According to the Staff appraisal of the World Bank, about 73 posts on various categories are to be created exclusively for this scheme. At the appraisal meeting held at Thiruvananthapuram on 26.4.1997 the representatives of World Bank and Central Government stressed upon the State Government to appoint the required staff for the implementation of the scheme at least before 30.6.1997.

3. Government after due consideration of urgency involved an appointment of necessary staff for implementation of this time bound World Bank assisted scheme and the non-availability of the staff re-deployment as intimated by the Chief Conservator of Forests, are pleased to accord sanction for creation of the following 46 new temporary posts in the department exclusively for the "India Eco Development Project Implementation in Periyar Tiger Reserve"
