2. After having examined the proposal of the Chief Conservator of Forests, Government are pleased to accord permission to conduct Forest Range Training in the ranges Training in ranges listed above, for the IVth year B.SC. (Forestry) students of Collage of Forestry, Vellanikkara as provided in the Curriculum for the course under the technical guidance and overall control and supervision of the Divisional Forest Officer of the given range/division. The Special officer, Collage of forestry will co-ordinate this work at the KAU level. In addition to technical guidance and supervision by the Divisional Forest Officers and Range Officers, a designated faculty member of the Collage of Forestry will also keep in the touch with the students periodically at their field

location for monitoring the progress of the programme.

3. A Certificate in the following form shall be issued by the respective Divisional Forest Officer to the trainees.

4. During the training period the students shall be permitted to collect all basic information about the particular range in respect of environmental characters, fauna and flora state of forest protection, extent of denudation, regeneration works, range management administration, cash accounts, working Plan, budget, miner forest produce, forest revenue, soiled and moisture conservation, assessment of crops, and such other areas of relevance. The final evaluation of the course at the KAU level shall be done by the course teacher to be designated by the Special Officer i/e Collage of Forestry, KAU, Vellanikkara.

The Forest Department shall not incur any additional expenditure towards the conduct of the above training.
