According to Para (ii) of the G.O read above a portion of D.A will treated as D.P at the rates detailed therein for the different pay ranges purpose of retirement benefits viz. Pension and gratuity. The Controller Account has raised the question whether the portion of D.A which been treated as D.P for Pension and gratuity should be reckoned for pose of calculation of leave salary and pension contributions recoverable behalf of government on deputation on foreign services on 1-4-1969.

According to Rule 146,Part 1 ,Kerala Service Rules, .P also has to reckoned for calculation of leave salary and Pension contribution . As a portion of the D.A would count for Pension according to the G.O cited first paper above. Governments are asked i.e the portion of D.A treated as D.P will also be taken into account for calculation of leave salary and pension contribution. These orders will apply also to case where officers are on deputation to Foreign Service on 1-4-1969.
