DEPARTMENTS- DEPUTATION ALLOWNCE SPECIAL PAY-LIMIT

ORDER

In the G.O read above it was orders that deputation allowance give to officers when sent rather on foreign service or to the central Government should be limited to 20% of the basic pay or Rs.300 whichever is less in all case where the Headquarters of the officer is located within the State and in cases of deputation of officers from one Department to another Department of the State Government ,the Special pay ,if any given to the deputation is should be limited to 20% of the basic pay or Rs.300 whichever is less if his headquarters is located with in the state . Government have examined the question of payment of deputation allowance special pay further and they consider that a distinction should be made in respect of respect of deputation allowance special pay admissible to officers with reference to the scale of the post to which officer is deputed. Accordingly they over that in cases where the transfer to foreign service or deputation to the central Government or to another Department of the state Governmnet is within kerala the deputation allowance / special pay will be regulated as follows:-

- (i) When the deputation is against a higher scale of pay the deputation Allowance special pay should be subject to the limit of 20% of basis pay or Rs 300 whichever less is.
 - (ii) Where the deputation is against a post having the same of scale pay the Maximum deputation allowance/special pay should be fixed as 105 of basic pay Rs.150 whichever less is.
2. These order will take effect from the date of issue and will apply also to all cases of extension of existing cases of deputation ordered on or after this date.
 3. The order in the G.O cited will stand modified to the above extent.
