**S.R.O.** No.385/71-In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Service Act, 1968 (19 of 1968), read with section 3 thereof the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendment to the Kerala Service Rules, namely:-

#### **AMENDMENTS**

C.S.No.222/71.

In part 1 of the said rules, in rule 60.

- (i) in sub rule (a) the words 'other than in last grade Service' occurring in the second and third lines shall be deleted.
- (ii) For sub-rule (b), the following rule shall be substituted, name:-"Officers in the Last Grade Service on 7-4-1970 will retire on attaining the age of 60 years provided that this benefits will be available to them only as long as they continue to be in the Last Grade Service as defined in rule 12 (16-A)"

These amendments shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 7-4-1970.
