ORDER

In the G.O. read as first and second papers, the benefit of Minimum pension of R.45 with effect from 1-3-1970 and Rs.50 with effect from 1-3-1972 respectively sanctioned to State pensioners, was extended to palace pensioners(Nithiachilavu pensioners). In the G.O.cited as 3rd paper, Government have ordered temporary increase in pension with effect from 1-7-1974 to all service pensioners who retired prior to July 1,1973 and whose basic pension does not exceed Rs.100 p.m. Some of the palace pensioners have represented that the benefit of the above enhancement in the minimum pension sanctioned with effect from 1-7-1974 may be extended to them also.

Government have considered the question in detail and are pleased to order that the benefit of temporary increase in pension ordered in the G.O read as 3^{rd} paper above will be extended to the place pensioners (Nithiachilavu pensioners) also.

These orders will take effect from July 1, 1974 i.e. the pension for the month of July 1974 due for payment in August 1974.
