Sub: - Public Service-Assignment of Indian personnel to Inter-nation organizations/Foreign Governments- Acceptance of their resignation while serving abroad-Instructions Issued.

Ref:- Letter No.7/18/76-FAS dated 2-6-1976 from the Governments of India, Cabinet Secretariat, Department of Personnel, New Delhi.

It is the current policy of the Government of India that Government Servants on deputation abroad, to International Organisations or Foreign Governments, who wish to resign from service should return to India and join their parent organization in this country before their resignations can be accepted. In the case of the employees of State Governments and employees of various quasi-Government Organization, the Government of India have, when seeking the release of an officer for deputation abroad been advising both the state Governments and the Officer himself of this policy. The Government of India have now pointed out that instance of State Governments accepting resignations from officers abroad on foreign assignment, have come to their notice and has therefore requested that suitable general instructions may be issued to all concerned.

In the circumstance and based on the current policy of the Government of India, Government direct that officers on deputation abroad to International Organisations or Foreign Governments who wish to resign from State Government Service/Service under quasi-Government Organisations as the case may be, shall return to India and join their parent Department/organization in the State before their resignations can be accepted. No restriction will however be imposed on the right of an officer to retire voluntarily if he is eligible to do so.

Heads of Departments and quasi-Government Organisations are requested to bring the above instructions to the notice of all concerned.
