ORDER

There are certain categories of employees in aided Schools who continue in service up to the age of 60 and in above case, service beyond the age of 55 will not count for pension. A doubt has arisen as to whether such employees could be admitted to the Family Benefit Scheme. Government have considered the question in all aspects and are pleased to order that employees of the type referred to above can be admitted to the Family Benefit Scheme, but the coverage under the scheme will be limited to the period of pensionable age. On attainment of the pensionable age their accounts will be closed and amount disbursed to them.
