Sub:- A.E.C.D. Act 1974—Premature Repayments of Compulsory Deposits—Reports to Government of India –Instructions Issued.

It has come to the notice of Government that some Heads of Departments and Offices are sending the reports regarding premature repayment of Compulsory Deposits to the Government of India direct. The Heads of Departments and Offices should not, hereafter, send the reports direct to the Government of India.

- 2. As already ordered in the Circular 3rd cited the Heads of Departments should send to Government the consolidated reports of all the employees working under them. (The reports should indicate the progressive figures and not the figures of the period under report).
- 3. Inspite of instructions it is also seen that some of the Heads of Offices are also sending reports to this department direct. As this will only result in duplication of figures the Heads of Departments may issue strict instructions to the subordinates to avoid sending of such statement direct to this Department.
