ORDER

According to the orders on the Government order as 1st paper above , medical examination is not necessary for commutation is made within one year of retirement on superannuation and in such cases commutation shall become absolute on the date on which the authority competent to sanction the pension accords sanction for the communication .

2. In the reference read as 2 nd paper above , Accountant general has made certain suggestions for procedural changes in the interest claims and avoidance of hardship to the pensioners

3. Government has examined the above suggestions in detail and is pleased to order as follows

(i) In cases where applications for commutation of pension are submitted before the date of retirement , commutation shall become absolute on the date of retirement . In such cases pension sanctioning authorities will accord provisional sanction for commutation also and will then forward the application for commutation to the Accountant General for verification and authorization of the payment .

(ii) In Cases where applications for commutation of pension are submitted on or after the date of retirement. but before the expiry of one year from the date of retirement commutations shall become absolute on the date of receipt of the application by the pension sanctioning authority .

(iii) The date of effect for the reduction in pension shall be the 1st of the months in which the commuted value is drawn by the pensioner or the 1st of the 4th month of the issue of authorization , by the A accountant General , including the month of issue of authorization whichever is earlier .

4 These orders will take effect from the date of issue .

5 . Amendments to the relevant rules , in K.S rs . Part 111 will be issued separately .
