**CIRCULAR**

*Sub:-* State Life Insurance (Official Branch) for new entrants in the State Government Service- Orders issued.

*Ref:-* 1. G.O. (P) 257/76/Fin. dated 19-8-1976.

3. Letter No. SL1/OB/8189/79 dated 5-4-1980 from the Director of State Insurance Department.

In the Government Order cited first, it was ordered that in the case of new entrants in Government Service, Life Insurance with the State Insurance (Official Branch) will be compulsory. As per the modification issued in the Government Order cited second, every person who enters Government Service on or after the 19<sup>th</sup> August 1976, shall within a period of one year from the date of entry in government Service, subscribe a policy in official Branch of the State Life Insurance at such rates as may be determined by Government from time to time and shall continue to subscribe till he ceases to be in Government Service.

The Director of Insurance in his letter 3<sup>rd</sup> cited has intimated Government that there is little, response from the Heads of Departments in respect of the above orders issued by the Government and hence has requested to issue necessary instructions in the matter making it binding on an employee to comply with the statutory provision laid down in Rule 22 Part 1, Kerala Service Rules. Instances are also brought to the notice of Government that some of the Heads of Department/Offices are not complying with the statutory provisions laid down in Rule 22 Part 1, Kerala Service Rules to insure the lives of it's employees with the State Insurance Department (Official Branch).

Considering the matter in detail, Government are constrained to bring the matter once again to the notice of all Heads of Departments/Offices to bring all new entrants in State Government Service within the coverage of the scheme within a period of 3 months from the date of issue of the order and to intimate the position to the State Insurance Department under intimation to Government. Government will view seriously any lapse on the part of any officer in complying with these directions.
