In the Government Order read as first paper above Government have ordered that pending issue of a new form of a new of application to be used forcommutation after medical examination (Form A) could be used for the purpose. In the Government Order read as second paper above, Government have prescribed a separate application form (Form D) for submitting application for commutation of pension without medical examination, The Accountant General in his letter read as third paper above has informed that many of the pensioners still continue to apply for communication of pension without medical examination in Form A instead of Form D and voce versa and applications received in the incorrect form will not be verified and reported for administrative sanction.
