NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Kerala hereby makes the following amendment to the Kerala Service Rules, namely:-

AMENDMENT

C.S.No. 34/62, Dated 12th November 1962

In Part I of the said rules; under rule 12(7) the following shall be added as Note 4.

“**Note 4-**” When a Government servant on return from leave has compulsorily to wait for orders of posting, the interval between the date of report and the date on which he takes charge, of his duties will be treated as ‘duty’ provided, that, the interval between the date of receipt of orders and his assumption of duties shall not in any case exceed the amount of joining time admissible under Rule 125 (a). During such period of duty he will be entitled to pay according to Rule 26”
