ORDER

The Government direct that a Tibetan who migrated to India before than 1st January 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India will be legible for appointment in the State Government service if there is a certificate of eligibility issued by the Government of India in his favor and if he is otherwise found suitable. The certificate of eligibility will be valid only for period of one year from the date of his first appointment beyond which he can be retained in service only if he has become a citizen of India.

2. A candidate in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary, may be admitted to an examination or interview conducted by the Kerala Public Service Commission or other recruiting authority, and he may also provisionally be appointed subject to the necessary certificate being given to him by the Government India.
