Sub:- Physical Standard – Amendment to Rule 12 of the Revised Rules for the Rangers' course in Forestry.

I am directed to say that some difficulties and doubt were being experienced in regard to the manner in which chest measurement of the candidates for admission to the Rangers' Course should be taken under the existing provision to Rule 12 of the "Revised Rules for Rangers course in Forestry". After careful consideration of the matter, it has been decided by the Government of India to amend the Rules to Read as following which would make the provision clear:-

"12. <u>Physical Standard</u>: The following minimum standards of height and chest girth are prescribed:

- i) Height.....163 cms.
- ii) Chest girth
  - (fully expanded). 84 cms.

Chest expansion. 5 cms.

iii) Candidates must pass a physical test consisiting of a walk of 25 kilometers to be completed in 4 hours".
