Read: Correspondence resting with letter No. E1- 4936/57 dated 7-7-1960 from the Chief Conservator of Forests.

ORDER

The question of formation of additional flying squads in the Forest Department to effectively prevent and detect smuggling of timber from reserve forests and also to check encroachments has been engaging the attention of Government for some time past.

2. Sanction is accorded for the formation of four more flying squads in the forest department in addition to the three squads now existing each squad will consist of one Ranger, one Forester and six Forest Guards. The existing 3 squads will be re organized in the above pattern. Sanction is also accorded for the creation of the following additional posts temporarily till the end of February 1961.

The jurisdiction of the seven flying squads will be redistributed as follows:-

- 1. Trivandrum, Quilon and Thenmala Division.
- 2. Konni and Ranni Division.
- 3. Kottayam Division.
- 4. Malayattor Division.
- 5. Trichur and Chalakudy Division.
- 6. Palghat and Nemmara Division.
- 7. Nilambur Kozhikode and Wynad Division.

3. Each part will be provided with a pick up van one dozen hand cuffs, one revolver and seven rifles, Each party will be provided with a building for office-cumresidence. This staff will be paid regular T.A. and other allowance admissible as per rules. Rewards will also be given to informants, the amount being met from contingency. The Chief Conservator of Forests is requested to forward necessary draft rules governing the grant of rewards to informants. The financial commitment will be as follows for the seven squads together.

This expenditure will be met from provision under '10 Forest (C) (i) District Offices' of the current year's budget.

4. Government consider that with the provision of these facilities it will be possible for the Department to control the encroachments and smuggling in forest areas effectively. The Chief Conservator of Forests is requested to see that encroachments are strictly dealt with in future. He is also requested to arrange for the vehicles being provided to the flying squads immediately. Any difficulty in the matter should be brought before Government, to consider the question of diversion of vehicles from other Departments, if necessary.
