ORDER

In the cited above, it was ordered that officers allotted and transferred from Madras to Kerala consequent on the States Reorganisation, who had qualified themselves in the Madras Special and Departmental Tests conducted by the Madras Public Service Commission in centers outside Kerala in 1957 and May, 1958 would be deemed to have passéd those tests for purpose of Madras Rules. It is seen that some of the allotted officers appeared for the tests conducted by the Madras Public Service Commission in November, 1958 in centers outside Kerala, and it has been requested that they need not be required to pass the same tests conducted by the Kerala public Service Commission again.

Government, in consultation with the public Services Commission, are pleased to order that the officers allotted and transferred from Madras consequent on State Reorganization who have passed the Madras Departmental and Special Tests conducted by the Madras Public service Commission in November, 1958 in centers out side Kerala needed not pass the same tests conducted by the Kerala Public Service Commission again.
