## ORDER

Investigation by the X-Branch Police into certain allegations against Sri. K.V. Madhavan, Range Officer, Ayyappan Coil disclosed a prima-facie case of misappropriation of Government money, manipulation of official records and other irregularities against him warranting disciplinary action. He was placed under suspension pending completion of the disciplinary proceedings contemplated against him. Specific Charges were farmed and his written statement of defence obtained.

2. Government have duly considered the explanation of the officer. They find that the explanation is unsatisfactory. They consider that the case against him should be proceeded with an enquired into in detail under the Kerala civil Services (Disciplinary proceedings Tribunal) rules 1960 and order accordingly.

3. Sri P.D. Nandana Menon, Tribunal for Disciplinary proceedings is requested to conduct the enquiry a according to the said Rules and to forward to Government a report with his finding and recommendations at an early date.

5. The Superintendent of Police, X-Branch and the Chief Conservator of Forests will render necessary assistance to the Legal Adviser to the CID of Police for the efficient conduct of the case before the Tribunal.
