## ORDER

Works connected with survey and demarcation of forest areas and disreservation of reserve forest areas proposed to be handed over to the Revenue Department for assignments have to be finished as expeditiously as possible. It is reported by the Chief Conservator of Forests that the regular staff in the Forest Dept. is not adequate to cope with thework. He has therefore proposed special staff for attending to the above mentioned works.

2. After having considered the proposal of the Chief Conservator of Forests, Government are pleased to create the following posts till the end of February 1970, for taking up the works connected with survey and demarcation of forest areas and disreservation of reserved forests proposed to be handed over to the Revenue Department for assignment.

2.	Head Surveyors	4	Rs.190-300
3.	Forest Grade Surveyors	12	Rs.130-250
4.	Second grade surveyors.	12	90-190

3. The expenditure involved will be debited to 70 forest (c) (iii) (c) But expenditure will be incurred only after the New service procedure is followed. The Chief Conservator of Forests will send up necessary proposals in the regard.

4. The work of the survey staff will be reviewed periodically by the Director of Survey and Land Records and quarterly progress report sent to Govt. in the Agriculture Department under intimation to the Chief Conservator of Forests.
