In the G.O.s referred to above, it was ordered that the advance T.A, granted to an officer should not exceed the actual T.A. admissible under the rules. Instances have however, been brought to the notice of Government wherein officers have drawn advance T.A. in excess if the amount actually admissible under the rules for the journey and refunded the advance part by part from subsequent T.A. Bills. The correct procedure is to limit the advance to the anticipated requirements of the tour and to adjust it in full when the decaled T.A. Bill for the journey is preferred, any balance left being remitted into the Treasury in full under intimation to the Comptroller. All Drawing Officers are therefore requested to follow this procedure a strictly.
