ORDER

In the G.O first read above, Government ordered that whenever drivers of Departmental motor vehicles are granted leave including casual leave for short periods not exceeding 15 days, the officers of the Departments concerned (appointing authorities) may appoint private drivers on a daily wage-rate of Rs.2/- (Rs. Two only) on their own responsibility for the proper use of the vehicles and the safety of the accessories, subject to the condition that this should be resorted to only when the officer is concerned that there is urgent necessity for taking out the vehicles, and the work cannot be managed by some internal arrangement. The Chief Conservator of Forests has now raised the point whether the drivers appointed in accordance with the above G.O are eligible for regular T.A also as per rules for the days they are in tour as in the case of departmental drivers, in addition to the daily wages Government have considered the matter and are pleased to order that actual expenses limited to T.A admissible to rivers in regular service may also be allowed to private rivers appointed in pursuance of G.O.MS. No.328 Public Services (D) Department, dated 2-5-1960, for the days they are on tour.
