Abstract

Calculation of incidental expenses for rail/Air journeys clarification-regarding.

The following three types of journeys arise in respect of claims for Travelling Allowance, (1) journeys purely within the State, (2) journeys purely outside the State and (3) journeys where one point (starting point or termination) may be with the State and the other outside the State. The question has been raised whether if the point of termination of the journey is within the State the rates of daily allowance as prescribed in the rule 39 will apply and whether if the point of termination of the journey is outside the State, the enhanced rates prescribed in Note 3 to Art 44 K.S.R will apply.

After having examined the question, Government are pleased to issue the following as a ruling under Note 3 to Rule 44 Part II of the K.S.R. in clarification of the point raised.

RULING

In respect of journeys where one point (starting point or termination) is within the State and the other is outside the State, daily allowance at half the total of the rates within the State and the rates outside the State may be allowed.
