Read:-Government of India Office Memorandum No.F-9 (13)-EV/60 dated 28-7-1960.

ORDER

In the above Memorandum, Government of India have issued orders to the effect that in the case of an officer who dies while on leave preparatory to retirement on a retiring pension, family pension may be granted to the family of the deceased officer for a period of 5 years from the date on which the officer would have retired on a superannuation pension in the normal course.

Government consider that the above provision may be included in the state rules and are accordingly pleased to issue the following as ruling under rule 83, part III, K.S.R.

RULING

In the case of an officer who dies while on leave preparatory to retirement on a retiring pension, the period of 5 years for the purpose of the grant of family pension should be reckoned from the date on which the officer would have retired on a superannuation pension in the normal course, and not the intended date of retirement on a retiring pension which did not however actually come about.
