ORDER

A doubt has been raised as to how the Permanent Travelling Allowance admissible to an officer should be regulated in cases where the officer is on duty for a part of a month and also in cases where the number of days of tour he has undertaken falls short of the minimum days of tour prescribed in a month to get the full amount of Permanent Travelling Allowance. Government have examined the question in detail and are pleased to order as follows:-

(a)If the officer was on duty for a part of a month he will be allowed proportionate P.T.A for the days he was on duty provided that the officer was on tour for the proportionate number of days with reference to the minimum days of tour prescribed.

(b) In cases where the officer has not toured for the minimum number of days prescribed, a deduction of X x P.T.A will be made where X and Y are the shortfall in the number of days of tour and the minimum number of days of tour prescribed in a month respectively.
