NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to the Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Kerala hereby makes the following amendments to the K.S. R. namely:-

AMENDMENT

C.S. NO.38/62

In Part II of the said rules, in rule 30

(1) the following shall be inserted as the second proviso, namely:-

“Provided further, that an officer who while on tour, is allowed free boarding and lodging at the expense of an autonomous, industrial or commercial undertaking or corporation or a statutory body or local authority in which Government funds have been invested or in which Government have any other interest, he may draw only one-fourth of the Daily Allowance admissible to him at the station concerned. If only boarding or lodging is allowed free to such an officer he may draw D.A at one half of the admissible rate”

(2) The existing note shall be numbered as note I and after note I as so numbered the following shall be inserted as Note 2, namely:-

Note: 2- A Government servant who stays during tours in Circuit houses, inspection bungalows/rest houses, etc., without having to pay any charges for accommodation, will draw D.A at one half of the appropriate rate. Where, however, such a Government servant is required to pay any charges on account of his stay at such places event though it may not cover the entire cost of the facilities provident, no reduction in the D.A will be made”.
