ORDER

By an amendment to their Fundamental Rules Government of India Have prescribed that a Government servant (including a workman) who is granted Extension of service after he has attained the prescribed age of superannuation. In the State Government Service, no Government servant is Allowed to continue in Service beyond the age of superannuation but he may be re-employed after retirement. However in the case of teaching staff, Rule 60 © Part I , Kerala Service Rules allows such continuance beyond the age of superannuation if the date of Retirement falls during the purse of an academic year subject to the conditions Specified therein. There no provision in the Kerala Service Rules at present to Present to prevent the teaching staff from being promoted during the period of their continuance in service after the age of retirement or superannuation. After Examing the question consultation with the Public Servant who is granted extension of service after thinking the age of superannuation, under Rule 60© Part I, Kerala choice Rules, will not be promoted to another post during the period of a.....ion
