**ORDER**

In the G.O. read as first paper above the rate of family pension admissible to the widows/minor children of a retired Government Servant governed by the Old rules in Kerala Service Rules, Part III, was fixed at the minimum of Rs. 20 P.M. for the period of payment extended on the lines of the Liberalised Family Pension Scheme. In the G.O. read as second paper above the rate of minimum family pension admissible under the Liberalised Family Pension Scheme was enhanced and fixed at Rs 25 P.M.

2. Representations have been received from recipients of the lower rate of pension that they too be given the higher minimum allowed to those governed by the Liberalised Family Pension Scheme. Government are convinced that number of pensioners coming under this category is limited and it is only fair that the concession is extended to these pensioners also. They are, therefore, pleased to order that the minimum rate of family pension admissible under the two Schemes be unified and fixed at Rs. 25 P.M. from the rate of this order.
