ORDER

It has been brought to the notice of Government that the dead and fallen valuable trees in Revenue land are now being auctioned by Revenue Department, but the process is very slow and price fetched is also very low due to the following reasons.

- i) Delay in completing the formalities of auction and sale confirmation.
- ii) Exposure of trees to rain, sun and climate conditions reduce the timber value.
- iii) If the value of trees exceeds Rs. 25,000/- its valuation has to be done by Forest Department.
- iv) Revaluation is required if sale is not confirmed or if there is substantial difference in upset price and maximum bidder price.
- 2. The question of avoiding the delay in completing the formalities of auction and to get maximum value for the dead and fallen trees was considered by Government in detail and they are pleased to issue the following revised procedure for disposal of dead/fallen trees in Government land.
- a) The dead and fallen trees will be inspected by a team consisting of Revenue officials, and forest officials. The team would consist of one Revenue Inspector, Forester/Range Officer and the concerned Village Officer. The Forest Department and Revenue Department will maintain a marking

register showing the details of the survey numbers, nature of the along with the basis of valuation and the details of valuation, which should be jointly authenticated by the Revenue Department and the Forest Department. The joint team will act as check and balance.

- b) The concerned Assistant Conservator of Forests, Social Forestry Division is to permit falling of trees.
- c) The fixation of value of trees as well as the sale will be conducted by the concerned territorial District Forest Officers after completing usual formalities and procedure.
- d) Auction will be conducted at site in order to avoid the problems of cutting transportation, security etc.
- e) Confirmation of auction sale will be by the District Collector for speedy action.
- f) The sale proceeds will be remitted to Revenue Department.
