Sir,

With a view to bring about improvement in the health care, upkeep and well – being of animal kept in our zoos, some of the provisions of the existing Recognition of Zoo Rules, 1992, has been amended vide Government of India vide Gazette Notification dated 11th July 2001. Copy of the Gazette Notification is enclosed.

2. These amendments, among other, prescribe mandatory educational qualification for the supervisory level staff, Viz., Curators and Veterinarians. The State Government/Municipal Corporations are now required to deploy personal of requisite qualification to these positions in the zoos under their administrative control.

3. It is requested that strict enforcement of standards and norms prescribed under the amended rules may please be ensured.
