ORDER

In the Government Orders cited, instructions were issued restricting expenditure on official telephone and telephone charges as part of measures to enforce economy in Government expenditure.

2. In continuation of the orders issued therein the following further orders are issued in regard to use of official telephones for strict compliance.

- (i) The Inter-Dialing Group Dialing Facility, which permit calling members in other districts from telephones without STD facility using Code Nos. like '95', '912' etc. available in the official telephones in Government Orders (without STD) will be withdrawn with immediate effect.
- (ii) All the Heads of offices the custodian of phone concerned will apply in writing immediately to the BSNL authorities concerned requesting to terminate the above facility from the official telephones under their control.

3. All the Heads of Departments are directed to issue necessary instructions to their subordinate offices in this regard. The Head of Office/custodian of the place will be responsible for effective implementation of these orders.
