Sub:- Maintenance of Plantation Journals -lapses Noticed - Instructions-issued-Regarding

The prevailing rules in the Department and directions from this office from time to time prescribe for the proper maintenance of plantation Journal for each plantation. The Committee constituted for the inspection of failed plantatins reported that in many cases plantation journals were not available or maintained up to date and hence the exact reasons for failure or other wise could not be identified. The lapse in maintaining the plantation journals is viewed as a serious irregularity. All officers ocncerend are hereby instructed that plantation journal for each plantation should be maintained properly and inspection notes recorded carefully whenever plantation is inspected by the officers. The plantation journal should be made available at the time of inspection by the officer. The receipt of this circular should be acknowledged.
