In the circulars cited, Instruction was issued on the procedure for the down of amount under: 8674 Security deposits under by Government and subsequent adjustments. As per the circular instructions, in cases where amounts are initially deposited in court by debit to the suspense head "8674 Security deposits made by Government" the concerned departments will have to move for Supplementary Grants, If the Government loses the same so as adjust the amount so deposited in courts under the appropriate functional Major heads. The Accountant General (Audit) Kerala, Thiruvananthapuram in his letter 4th cited has pointed out that the balance an "8674-99 Deposits of decial amount is in Courts for storing execution of decrees" rose from in 877.90 Lakhs on 31.3.1991 to Rs.1372.16 Lakhs as on 28.2.1994. He is also requested for urgent action for clearing the huge debits outstanding under the suspense head.

In the circumstances, all Heads of Departments and administrative Departments in secretariats and directed to take immediate steps for clearing the debits outstanding under the suspense head "8674-101-99 Deposit of decial amounts to Courts for execution of decrees" by providing the required amount under the respective functional hands by moving supplementary grants as per the instruction force.
