S.R.O.No.623/97 - In exercise of the powers conferred by sub section (1) of section 5 of the Kerala preservation of Trees Act. 1986 (35 of 1986 the Government of Kerala hereby direct that no tree standing in the are specified in the Schedule below shall be cut , uprooted , burnt or otherwise destroyed except on the ground that-

- (a) the tree conditutes a danger to life or property;
- (b) The tree is dead , deceased or windfallen.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

The area specified above comprised in Forest Division, Thrissur is a portion of the private forest coming under the erstwhile Malabar preservation of private Forests Act, 1949. The lands were vested in Government till restoration. The petitioner in O.A 808/75 succeeded in getting the land restored to him. The area supports thick growth of teak trees. It is likely that the petitioner on restoration of land would remove the tree growth of the area causing wanton destruction of forest resulting in ecological imbalance including land slides and soil erosion. Government have, therefore, decided to bring the above specified private forest area within the purview of section 5 of the Kerala preservation of Trees Act, 1986, so as to prevent felling of trees from the above area.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
