**Forest & Wildlife Department - Guidelines for allowing permissive use of the forestland for conducting training in paragliding - Sanctioned - Orders issued.**

**ORDER**

**In the circumstances reported by the Secretary, Tourism Department vide his letter read as 2nd cited sanction is accorded to the Adventure Sports and Sustainable Tourism Academy for conducting the International paragliding Championship at Vagamon from April 6 - 12 subject to the following conditions.**

1. The Kerala Forest Department will not take any responsibility for any accident/injury if any, taken place during the training.
2. The party has to deposit a security of Rs.15000/- (Fifteen thousand only) and pay a fee of Rs.5000/- day during the training period.
3. The party will be permitted to undertake training programme only during day time between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.
4. The party is not allowed to do any kind of cooking in the Forest area.
5. The party will not do any clearing in forest areas.
6. The party will not construct any structure whether permanent or temporary in the area.
7. The party shall be responsible to keep the area free from litter. The litter generated if any should be collected and disposed outside the limits of Reserve Forests.
8. If the party violates any terms and conditions, the security deposit will be forfeited to Government besides stopping training programme forthwith.

10. The party should execute agreement on stamp paper with the Divisional Forest Officer concerned including all the above conditions as well as any other conditions not listed above as found necessary by the Divisional Forest Officer.
