LOANS AND ADVANCES TO GOVERNMENT SERVANTS-RECOVERY DURING
MAY 1981-POSTPONED-ORDERS ISSUED.

With a view to giving financial relief to the low paid employees of the State who have to incur considerable expenditure towards the education of their children, when the educational institutions reopen after the summer vacation, Government are pleased to order that recovery on account of repayment of principal and payment of interest during May 1983 in respect of all loans and advances taken by Non-Gazetted Officers including those borne on contingent and work establishment and Gazetted Officers drawing a basic upto Rs.1,000 per month will be postponed.

2. These orders will apply to the teaching and non-teaching staff of aided school and private colleges who are paid from the consolidated fund of the State.

3. The benefit of this order will be extended to all the Non-Gazetted Officers and Gazetted Officers drawing pay upto Rs.1.000 per month of the local bodies including contingent and work establishment staff in respect of the loans and advances taken by them from the local body concerned.

4. The recovery of the instalment in respect of loans and advances hereby postponed will be effected in five equal monthly instalments starting with the salary for August 1983 and ending with the salary for December 1983.
