Joint Verification of occupied forest areas - Completion seeking approval from Government of India for regularisation -Orders issued.

As per the reference cited, Government ordered joint verification of occupied forestlands including vested forest land, jointly by Forest and Revenue Departmentsin districts where joint verification of occurred forestlands had not been completed.

2. When the proposal of the State Government, susmitted in 1986 for regularisation of 28588.159 hectares of occupied forestlands prior to 1-1-1977 in five districts (Idukki, Thri E_nakulam, Pathanamthitta and Kollam) was under consideration of Government of India for conction, State Government was ache to intimate tre details of forest area to be regularised in al the districts in prescribed proforma. When the correspondent was going on between State Government and Government of India sanction for first proposal, Government of India on 2-4-1992 asked the State Government for details of for st area to be regularised with all details in the prescribe proforma. The State Government had written to Government of In ia in 17-7-1992 that the total area which will have to be regularised conseque nt on completion of joint verification exercise of encroached forest area in all the districts would be around 46000 hectares including 28,588.159 hectares (ocular assessment It was also stated that the detailed proforma report along will other necessary documents with area to be regularised would be submitted after joint verification was over.

3. The joint verification was accordingly conducted as per reference cited in the following forest circles and the pracess have more or less been completed. The details of joint verification are as follows:

While granting sanction under section 2 of the Fore Conservation Act 1980 for diversion of 28588.159 hectares of forest land in five districts for regularisation of pre 1-1 encroachment and to assign land under Kerala Land assignment (Regularisation of Occupation of Forest Land Prior to 1-1-7 Special Rules 1993, Government of India have stated that sugsanction was subject to condition laid down vide letter No.8-118/86-FC dated 23-3-1993. In the said letter, Government of India had put following conditions:

- i. Ground verification and demarcation of area to be regularised in favour of individual encroachers shall be done by the State Government.
- ii. Regularisation of encroachments shall not be done in favour of encroachers (otherwise found eligible) either in the midst of the forest area or in the periods Tigor Roservo (Wild Life Sanctuary For
- Periyar Tiger Reserve/Wild Life Sanctuary. For stopsuch encroachers area in excess of dound acres available with other eliquide encroachers may be utilised.
- iii. Detailed map showing demarcation of the area to be regularised in favour of individual encroachers, shabe got prepared.
- iv. Regularisation of encroachments in favour of eligiencroachers shall not be done in excess of the alea
 permissible as per Kerala Land Assignment Fules 19:
 The excess area with such encroachers shall be tak
 from the possession of the encroachers and shall
 utilised for shifting eligible encroachers from
 midst of the forest area or from Penivar Tigan
 Reserve area.

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encroachers shall be taken back from the possession of an encroachers and shall be utilised for shifting eligible encroachers from the midst of the forest area or from Periyal Tiger Reserve area.

- v) a comprehensive scheme for soil conservation and agro-forestry shall be prepared and implemented as a time bound programme to check accelerated soil erosion and siltation of dams taking place in the area.
- vi) The State Government shall give firm commitment that funds for the compensatory afforestation scheme will be made available. The compensatory afforestation shall be done within a period a exceeding 5 years.

On the basis of Government order dated 31.8.1989, joint visit fication was conducted jointly by Forest and Revenue officials. The outcome of the joint verification and the area subject to joint verification by Forest and Revenue Officials is shown in the table above. Out of 27,680.23 hectares to be verified 23,929.567 hect were subjected to joint verification and 13,892.47 hectares were found to be occupied prior to 1.1.1977. The area remaining to the verified is about 3750.76 hectares.

Government have examined the matter in details and orders as follows:

- India for sanction under section 2 of the Forest Conservation 1980 for regularisation of 13892.478 hectures that has already found to be occupied prior to 1.1.1977 in the joint verificati conducted. The District Collectors will immediately prepare p forma report for the said area from the joint verification recand submit to Government before 31st December 1999 for submitt a consolidated proposal to Government of India.
- 2. The remaining area of 3750.763 hootares for which joint of cation is yet to be completed will be done within two months by Forest and Revenue officials as had been done in the past the basis of such joint verification, District Collectors will ward the preferme details to Government before 5.2.2000.

TERMINAL MARKET

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3. This submitting the proposal to Government of India, the State Government will undertake to stand by the same terms and conditions that were imposed in the earlier proposal by Government of India.
