NOTIFICATION

S.R.O No. 1142/75 – In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968) the Government of Kerala hereby made the following further amendment to the Government Servants Conduct Rules, 1960 published under G.O. (p) No. 6/ Public dated 5.31.19860 in the Kerala Gazette dated the 12<sup>th</sup> January, 1960, as subsequently amended, namely:-

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 44, for the third proviso the following proviso shall be substituted, namely:-

“Provided also that persons employed in the Co-operative Department may become members of Co- operative. Housing Societies or of Co-operative credit societies if such persons are not directly in charge of the supervision or audit of those Co-operative Societies subject to the restriction that in case any such person after becoming member of any such Co-operative Society becomes directly in charge of the supervision or audit of the society he/she shall report the matter forth with to his/her controlling officer who shall transfer the supervision or audit of that Society to any other officer in the District or neighboring District as the case may be.”

Explanatory Note

This note is not part of the notification but is intended to indicate its general purport.

In G.O. (P) No. 237/72/PD dated 16.5.1972 Government have permitted the employees of the Co-operative Department to become members of Co-Operative Housing Societies or Co –operative Credit Societies subject to the restriction that they should not have jurisdiction to supervise or audit those Co-operative Societies. The Co-operative Inspectors and Auditor's Association has pointed out that if an employee of the Co-

operative Department who is a member of the Co-operative Credit Society is not permitted to have jurisdiction over that Society that, means that he cannot avail membership of that society be it situated anywhere in Kerala. So also if an employee of the Co-operative Department who has membership in a Co-operative Housing Society is not permitted to have jurisdiction over such society never in his service period can he work in his native locality or the locality where he has constructed a house or purposes to construct a house by availing of the privilege as a member of such society. The association has therefore requested that the orders issued in the above G.O. may be modified in such a way that the particular society or societies in which the employee of the Department is a the members affairs of the society may be entrusted to any other officer in the district or neighboring district of neighboring district .This notification tended to issue revised order as requested by the association.
