NOTIFICATION

S.R.O. No. 378/76. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to clause (3) of article 320 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Kerala hereby makes the following amendment to the Kerala Public Service Commission (Consultation) Regulations, 1957, namely:-

AMENDMENT

In the Annexure to the said Regulations, for items 6, under the heading Subordinate Services, the following item shall be substituted, namely:-

6. Absorption of supernumeraries or personnel declared surplus in one service in another service or in another department of the same service, wherein the opinion of Government the qualifications are similar to those of the supernumerary posts or posts declared surplus, as the case may be."

Explanatory Note

(This note is not part of the notification but is intended to indicate its general purport)

There are instants in several departments where certain posts are declared surplus and consequently the persons holding the posts are retrenched. Government have decided that, if possible, the persons declared surplus may be absorbed in open vacancies of posts in another service or in another department of the same service the qualifications prescribed for which are similar to those of the posts declared surplus, without consulting the Public Service Commission. This notification is intended to achieve the above object.
