"17. Posts of Peon in the Lottery Offices at New Delhi and Calcutta."

Explanatory Note

(This Note does not form part of the Notification but is intended to indicate its general purport)
At present the Appointment to the posts of peons in the lottery Offices at New Delhi and
Calcutta which according to the existing rules come within the purview of the Kerala Public Service
Commission are being made through Employment Exchanges on contract basis. As the appointment of
persons to the above last grade posts from Kerala leads to many difficulties and unnecessary
expenditure, it has been proposed to take away the posts from the purview of the Public Service
Commission and to fill them up through the local Employment Exchange. This Notification is
intended to achieve the above object.
