S R O no 200/71- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub section (1) of the Kerala Public Service Act,1968(19of 1968) the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendments to the Kerala State and Subordinate Services Rules, 1958 ,namely;-

AMENDMENTS

In part II of the said Rules, in rule15;-

(i) for the words and figures “this amendment shall be deemed to have been come in to effect from1-11-1966” occurring at the end, the following words and figures shall be substituted, namely;-

“ This amendment shall be deemed to have come in to effect from 15-6-1967”.

(ii) the following note shall be added at the end, namely;-

‘Note;-The year of reservation referred to above shall be from the 15th June of a calendar year to 14th June of the succeeding calendar year. The ROTATION referred to above shall commence from15-6-1967and the outstanding compensation due to communities in the cycle of rotation up to 15-6-1967 will be treated as lapse “

Explanatory Note

(This note is of part of the amendment but is intended to indicate its general purpose) According to the amendment issued to General Rule 15 in G O (MS 145/PD dated 5-5-1967, the benefit of a turn forfeited to a community or group by reason of it being passed over due to the non- availability, if a suitable candidate from the community or group is available for selection by making adjustment against the claims of the community group that derived the extra benefit by reason of such passing over. This amendment was given retrospective effect from 1-11-1966.But g 1247. In pursuance of a decision taken at a conference, the Public Service Commission had been following a different procedure from 1-11-1966, adjusting the passed over claims of the reservation group communities against the turn of the next community in the order in which they occurred in the rotation. So the action of the Public Service commission in having followed a procedure different from the one prescribed in G O (MS) 145/PD. Dated5-5-1967 during the period from 1-11-1966 to 14-6-1967 has to be ratified. It has also been decided that the year of reservation referred to in rule15 may be from the 15th June of the succeeding calendar year, and the rotation referred to shall commence from15-6-1967 and outstanding compensation due to communities in the cycle of rotation up to 15-6-1967 will be treated as lapsed. The amendment is intended to achieve the above objects.
