AMENDEMENT

- 1. Short title and Commencement .- (1) These Regulations may be called the Kerala Public Service Commission (Consultation) Amendment Regulation, 1979.
- 2. They shall come into force at once.
- 3. 2. Amendment to the Regulation.- In the Annexure to the Kerala Public Service Commission (Consultation) Regulations, 1957, under the heading Subordinate Service". After item 17, the following item shall be inserted namely:-
 - "18. Posts of Mahouts and Cavadies in the Forest Department."
