S R O No 268/76 ; - In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (i) of Section 2 of the Kerala Public services act 1968 (19 of 1968) read with section 3 of, the Government of Kerala State and Subordinate Services Rules, 1958 namely;-

AMENDMENT

In Part II of the said Rules, in sub rule (e) of rule 9, the following shall be added at the end, namely;-

“or is physically handicapped and was in service on any day during the period commencing on and from the 22nd December 1973 and ending with the 1st January, 1974.

Explanation;- For the purpose of the sub-rule physically handicapped includes the blind, the deaf and the orthopedically handicapped as explained below;-

- (a) The blind;- The blind are those who suffer from the following conditions;
- (i) Total absence of sight.
 - (ii) Visual acuity not exceeding 3/60 or 10/200 (snellen) in the better eye with correcting lenses.
- (b) The deaf- The deaf are those in whom the sense of hearing non – functional for the purpose of life.
- (c) The Orthopedically Handicapped- The orthopedically handicapped are those who have a physical defect or deformity which causes adequate interference to significantly impede normal functioning of the bones, muscles and joints.

The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on 28-4-1974.

Explanatory Note

(This note is part of the amendment but is intended to indicate its general purport)

Government have decided that the services of provisional (temporary) employees who are physically handicapped and who were in service on any day from 22-12-1973 to 1-1-1974 may be regularized, irrespective of the length of their service. But before issuance of orders regularizing the provisional (temporary) services of these employees, an enabling provision to that effect has to be incorporated under sub- rule (e) of rule 9 of the Kerala State and Subordinate Services Rules, Part II. This notification is intended to achieve the above object..
