## NOTIFICATION

G.S.R......In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection(1) of section 3 of the All India Service Act, 1951 (61 of 1951), the Central government, after consultation with the Governments of the States concerned, hereby makes the following rules further to amend the All India Services (Medical Attendance) rules, 1954, namely:-

- 1. (1) These rules may be called the All India Services (Medical Attendance) Amendment Rules, 1969.
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication ion the Official; gazette.
- 2. In rule 2 of the All India Service (Medical Attendance) Rules, 1954 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), in sub0clause (iii) of clause (k), after the words "in the State" the words excluding the preparations which be primarily used as food, tonic, toilet or disinfectant" shall be inserted.
- 3. In rule 14 of the said rules, after clause (1) the following clause shall be inserted, namely:"(ia) entitle a member of the Service to re-imbursement of any cost incurred in respect of
  preparations which are primarily used as food, tonic, toilet or disinfectant, or"
