INDIAN FOREST SERVICE – Policy in regard to the posting of Indian Forest Service direct recruits and designation- orders issued.

ORDER

The Government have under consideration for some time the question of formulating a scheme for appropriate posting to direct recruit IFS officers with a view to developing their potentialities and equipping them for positions of higher responsibilities. The Government are now pleased to issued the following guideline in then matter:-

- 1. A direct recruit IFS Officer will be posted,. After completion of its training in the Department, as on Assistant to a deputy Conservator of Forests holding charge of Territorial Division to enable him to gain mastery over all aspects of the work of a Division Conservator of Forests.
- 2. A Direct recruitment IFS Officer Will be promoted to senior scale on completion of 4 years of service and an passing the prescribed departmental tests.
- 3. On promotion to senior scale be will be posted to be in charge of a Territorial Division, as Deputy Conservator of Forests, where he should work for a fairly reasonable period.
- 4. Thereafter, the direct recruit IFS Officer will be given postings in senior scale posts at the head quarters.
- 2. The above guidelines will e followed with immediate effect and every effort should be made to effect future postings accordingly.
- 3. The State Forest Service Officers holding charge of the Divisions will continue to be designated as divisional Forest Officer.
