PUBLIC SERVICES - THE KERALA FOREST SUBORDINATE SERVICE - SPECIAL RULES – ISSUED

Public (Rules) Department NOTIFICATION

G.O Ms. NO . 652/62.

Dated, Trivandrum, 29th November 1962.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the constitution of India and of all other powers hereunto enabling and in supersession of all the rules and orders on the subject, the Government of kerala hereby makes the following special rules in respect of the kerala Forest Subordinate service, namely;

RULES

1. Constitution . - The Service shall consist of the following classes and categories of officers of the Forest Department , namely ;-

CLASS I

Category 1 Rangers.

- 2 Deputy Rangers, I grade and II grade.
- 3 Forests
- 4 Forest Guards, I Grade and II grade
- 5 Forest Apprentices.

CLASS II CURATOR OF MUSEUM

2. Appointment .- Appointment to the several classes, categories and grades shall be made as follows;-

CLASS 1.

Category 1. - Rangers

Method (2)

- (1) Appointment of Forest Apprentices in the manner prescribed in Rule 9, or
- (2) Promotion of Deputy Rangers in either of the Regional Forest Rangers Colleges, or Coimbatore or Dehra Dun.
- (3) Promotion of Deputy Rangers and Forests who have not been trained as Rangers, but have had training as Forests.

Provided that 50 per cent of the vacancies arising in the Category of shall be filled Rangers bv the appointment of Forest Apprentices, 30 per cent by promotion of Deputy and **Foresters** who have Rangers undergone Rangers training and 20 percent by promotion of Deputy Rangers and Forests untrained as Rangers, but trained as Forests;

Provided, however, that senior t5rainned Forests (0r Deputy Ranger) will be superseded by a junior untrained Forester on the ground that 30% ear- marked for trained Forests has already been filled up, If suitable trained Deputy Rangers or Forests are available for promotion vacancies allotted to them may be filled up provisionally by promotion Deputy Rangers or Forests who have undergone Forests training in a Regional Forests School . Such persons shall be replaced immediately on persons trained as Rangers becoming available.

Note ;- A candidate who has secured the 1st rank in a Regional Forests School and has put in more than ten years service in the Department of which five years are spent as Forester will be considered eligible for promotion on the Quota allocated for promotion of Deputy Rangers and Forests trained as Rangers.

Promotion of Deputy Rangers, Grade II

Promotion of Forests Trained in a Regional Foresters' School

Provided that Forests who have put in 15 years' service and who are over 35 years of age shall be exempted from the Foresters' Training.

Category 3; - Foresters.

- (1) Promotion of Forest Guards;, or
- (2) Recruitment by transfer From members of the Ministerial Service in the Forests Department., or
- (3) Direct recruitment Provided that
- (1) 25% of the vacancies arising in the category of Forests Shall be filled by direct requirements;
- (2) 50% by promotion of Guards possessing minimum general education al qualification of the S.S.L.C standard or equivalent
- Note; Guards with Foresters training will be given preference over guards trained in Guards Training schools promotion from such guards will be made according to seniority among them
- (3) 20% by promotion of Forests Guards who do not possess the minimum general educational qualification of the S.SL.C standard but who have put in 10 years service as guards and are literate and otherwise fit. Persons who have a pass certificate from one of the Forests Training Schools will be preferred in selecting person s for promotion against this quota.
- Note; A senior Forest Guard who possesses the minimum general educational qualification of the S.S.L.C standard, will not be superseded by a junior possessing the above qualification to maintain the 20% quota. Such senior persons will be promoted before a junior Forests guard without the minimum general educational Qualification of the S.S.L.C standard is promoted.
 - (4) 5% by appointment by transfer of members of the Ministerial Service in the Forest Department

Category 4-Forest Guard .1 Grade promotion from Forest Guards II

GRADE

Forest Guards, 11 grade

- (1) Direct requirements including recruitments from among Lascars who have put in five years service in the Department
 - (2) Recruitment by transfer from peons who have put in 5 years service in the forest Department.

Note ;- Not more than 10% of the vacancies shall be filled or reserved to be filled by transfer of peons employed in the Department and not more than 1 5% by direct recruitment from among Lacers, Masteries and Watchers in the Department.

Category 5- Forest Apprentices . Direct recruitment .

CLASS II

Curator of Museum.

By appointment of Deputy Rangers Grade or promotion of deputy Rangers, 11 grade or Forests.

5. Qualification regarding age - (a) Save as provided in sub -rule (b) no person shall be eligible for appointment by direct requirements to any post if he has completed or will complete 25 years of age on the 1st July of the year in which applications for appointment are invited, with the usual relaxation for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other BACKWARD Classes.

- (b) (i) For appointment to the post of Forests Apprentice , the age limit prescribed by the Government of India from time to time for admission to the Ranger's Course in the Northern Forest Rangers college , Delhi Dun and the southern Forest Rangers college, Coimbatore will be followed .
- (ii) No watcher, lascar, Maistry or Peon in the Forest Department shall be eligible for appointment as Forest Guard if he has completed 30 years of age on the date of a appointment.
- 6. Other qualification No person shall be eligible for appointment to the class, category or grade specified in column (1) and by the qualifications specified in the corresponding entry in column (3) therefore;
