S.R.O.No. In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1963 (19 of 1968) read with section 3 there of, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendment to the special Rules in respect of the Kerala Forest Service issued in G.O.(P)No. 429/66 Public Department dated the 5th November, 1960 and published in Part I of the Kerala Gazette No. 46 dated the 22nd November, 1966, namely:-

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 4 for the entries in column (2) against 'Direct recruitment' in column (1) the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“(i) Must possess the qualifications prescribed by the Govt. of India from time to time for admission to the Diploma Course in Forestry.

(ii) Should be not less than 19 years or more than 30 years of age on the 1st day of January of the year in which applications are invited for admission to the Diploma Course.

Provided that the upper age-limit shall be relaxed in the case of Departmental candidates, namely, trained Rangers in Government Service, by not more than 5 years

Provided further that the upper-age-limit shall be relaxed by 5 years in the case of scheduled castes/sch. Tribes (both direct recruits and departmental candidates) and by 3 years in the case of candidates belonging to other Backward Classes, (both direct recruits and departmental candidates).

Provided also that the maximum age-limit in the case of Ex- Servicemen shall be 37 years.”

Explanatory Note

(This note does not form a part of the notification but is intended to make clear its general purport)

Hitherto the age-limit for appointment to the post of Assistant Conservator of Forests was as prescribed by the Government of India from time to time for admission to the Diploma Course in Forestry in the Forest Research Institute and college, Dehra Dun. The Government of India have since amended their rules to the effect that the minimum and maximum age limit will be as prescribed in the rules by the respective Government for this post. Hence it became necessary to include provision in the special rules of the State Government regarding age and so the amendment.
