Explanatory Note

(This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general purport).

Rule 2(14) of the kerala state and subordinate service rules 1958, defines the term “scheduled caste and scheduled tribes” as the castes and Tribes declared as such by the president of India under art 341 (1) and 342 (1) of the constitution of India and ‘other backward classes’ as the classes declared as such by the state government under 16 (4) of the constitution. Lists of such castes tribes and classes so declared are included as lists I , II, III in the schedule to part I of the said rules. Consequent on the scheduled castes and scheduled tribes orders (Amendment) Act,1976 which has been brought in to force with effect from 27-7-1977 the list of scheduled castes and scheduled tribes communities in kerala have been revised by the Government of India. As a result some of the classes which were hitherto included among the “other backward classes’ have been listed as scheduled castes/scheduled tribes. It has therefore become necessary to substitute the existing lists in the scheduled to part I of the kerala state and subordinate services rules 1958. this notification to intended to achieve the above object.
