S.R.O No 526/78- In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services act 1968 (19 of 1968), read with section 3 thereof the Government of kerala hereby make the following amendment to the kerala state and subordinate service rules 1958, namely;-

AMENDMENT

In part II of the said Rules in rule 4

(i) for items 1 and 2 the rates specified against them the following shall be submitted namely;-

“1. For posts in the state services the minimum pay of which is Rs. 435 and above.

(ii) Items 3,4,5 and 6 shall be deemed to have come into force with effect on and from 1-12-1977.

(This note does not form part of the notification but is intended to indicate its general purport)

In G.O MS No 360/77/ GAD dated 28-10-1977, Government issued orders with effect from 1-12-1977 simplifying the revised scheme of distribution of embossed public service commission application forms. Interalia it has been ordered in the G.O that application forms of the embossed value of Rs15 will be dispensed with. This order necessitates services rules 1958.
